Florence, S.C. (WPDE) — A voluntary manslaughter charge has been dismissed against Nastedman Freeman, Jr. in a deadly bar fight in October of 2016 after a judge ruled his actions were in compliance with the "Stand Your Ground" law, according to Twelfth Circuit Solicitor Ed Clements.

Police said they found that Freeman and 27-year-old Carol S. "Trey" Altman had a brief verbal altercation and Freeman punched Altman and he fell to the floor.

Altman was taken to the hospital and later died.
